

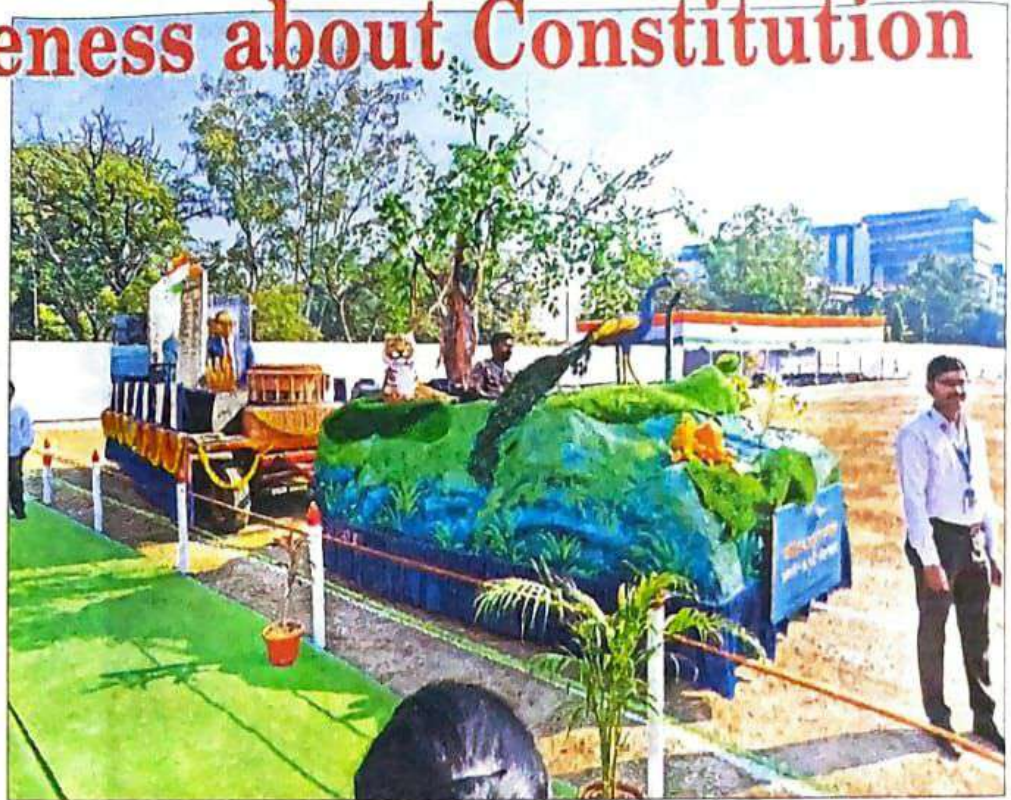
Specially designed tableau touring city to raise awareness about Constitution

IN COMMEMORATION of the Amrit Mahotsav of the Indian Constitution, the Social Welfare Department of Nagpur, in collaboration with the Nagpur Municipal Corporation, has launched a public awareness campaign. A specially designed tableau is touring all ten zones of the city to raise awareness about the Constitution.

The campaign was inaugurated on Republic Day, January 26, by Guardian Minister Chandrashekhar Bawankule. Under the guidance of Municipal Commissioner Dr Abhijit Chaudhary, and led by Assistant Commissioner of the Social Welfare Department, Sukeshini Telgote, the tableau is travelling to all ten zones of the city to spread awareness.

The initiative aims to educate citizens about their constitutional rights and duties. The tableau, created by the Social



Welfare Department, began its tour on January 27 and has since covered various areas under the Nagpur Municipal Corporation (NMC).

On Thursday, January 30, the campaign visited Satranjipura zone from 10 am to 12 noon, covering Vit Bhatti, Pardi flyover, and Automotive Square.

Later in the day, from 4 pm to

6 pm, the tableau moved to Lakadganj zone, focusing on the Kacchi Visa Maidan area. The campaign has already reached the zones of Laxminagar, Dharampeth, Hanuman Nagar, Dhantoli, Nehru Nagar, and Gandhibagh, in the second capital and will continue to cover the remaining areas in the coming days.
